What to Include in Your Pitch Deck

1. Cover

- Your company's name, logo, and branding.
- The current date for context.

2. The Challenge and Your Solution

- o Clearly state the market problem your business addresses.
- Explain how your product or service solves this problem, emphasizing its transformative impact on lives, economies, or industries.

3. About Your Team

- o Introduce the key members of your team.
- Highlight relevant skills, achievements, and experience that make your team the right fit for scaling your business.

4. Your Product or Service

- o Provide visuals or a demonstration to show how your product works.
- o Explain how it fulfills a market need effectively and uniquely.

5. Market and Growth Opportunity

- o Detail your target market's size, demographics, and potential for growth.
- o Include data or visuals showcasing your market niche and future potential.

6. Competitive Edge

- Highlight your position relative to competitors.
- o Explain your unique value proposition and barriers to entry.

7. Revenue and Financial Performance

- Share your current revenue, growth trajectory, and financial projections for the next 3–5 years.
- o If applicable, mention past funding or backing from other investors.

8. Future Vision and Impact Goals

- o Articulate your long-term vision.
- Explain how your business creates measurable economic, social, or environmental benefits.

9. Your Ask

- o Clearly state the amount of funding you're seeking.
- Detail how the funds will be allocated and the type of strategic or technical support you're seeking from our partners.

10. Contact Information

- o Include your business address, email, and phone number.
- o Provide links to any supporting resources or data rooms.
